
## **Personal Finance Lab**

## Step 1: Access Personal Finance Lab in AET

## **Step 2: Personal Budgeting Game for AET Teachers and Students**

- The Budget Game on PersonalFinanceLab.com allows your students to take the roll of college student, with a job, and living on their own
- It will challenge your students to manage their variable income along with their monthly expenses, while trying to build up their net worth, credit score, and social life
- It will take about 20 minutes for your students to go through one virtual month and it is recommended to play for 12 virtual months
